Donald L. Detwiler Receives ACPA's Hartmann-Hirschman-Egan Award

Pennsylvania businessman, Donald L. Detwiler, recognized with prestigious, national award for his career-long impact on the transportation industry.

NEW ENTERPRISE—The American Concrete Pavement Association (ACPA) recognizes Donald L. Detwiler, of New Enterprise Stone & Lime Company (New Enterprise, Pennsylvania), as the 2018 recipient of the ACPA Hartmann-Hirschman-Egan Award.

This is the most coveted award presented by ACPA. The award recognizes individuals, companies, and organizations for unparalleled commitment, dedication, and leadership in the concrete pavement industry.

“Don Detwiler served and led the industry nationally and locally in Pennsylvania with class and vision,” said Chuck Niederriter, 2018 Chairman of ACPA. “He led the way in getting our first chapter off the ground in the northeastern United States. He also assisted the industry through challenging times as ACPA’s chairman in 1979.” Detwiler was also elected as the first Life-Member of the ACPA Pennsylvania Chapter (ACPA/PA) in 2012.

“Under his guidance, New Enterprise achieved the Mile-a-Day Club on a few occasions, paving over a million square yard in one season. We estimate that Don was involved with over 14 million square yards of concrete paving. I think it is safe to say that he has built more concrete roads in Pennsylvania than any other company,” he added.

Detwiler has been a Director at New Enterprise Stone & Lime Company since 1972 and is currently its Vice Chairman. He previously held the positions of Chief Executive Officer and of President.

The Hartmann-Hirschman-Egan Award, first presented in 1968, is named in honor of the late Harold W. Hartmann, the late Robert E.
