



# **CONTRACTOR MEMBER FEES - 2023**

**1. Annual Dues**

- Membership with ACPA/PA is on a calendar (Jan 1 to Dec 31) basis; annual dues are payable in full by January 31.
- For new members, annual dues are prorated quarterly. Companies joining ACPA/PA in the fourth quarter shall pay annual dues in full for the following year, but their membership begins immediately.
- ACPA/PA Contractor members are automatically members of ACPA/National; all dues/assessments for work in Pennsylvania are included with ACPA/PA fees; ACPA/PA will forward payments to ACPA/National.
- Assessable work performed in other Chapter/States to be paid to them at their rates; assessable work performed in non-affiliated areas to be paid directly to ACPA/National at \$0.55 /\$1,000.

**2. Markets & Payments**

- Applicable for work in the Pennsylvania highway, tollway, airport, and street & local road markets.
- Members are responsible for self-reporting to ACPA/PA all assessable work within 60-days of work being awarded/secured; the Chapter will invoice work accordingly.
- 65% of all assessments are due within 60-days of when concrete pavement/repair work commences, with the balance to be paid within 60-days of when at least 90% of the contract work has been completed and the project can be used, occupied, or operated for its intended use.
- Members are asked to consider making a voluntary contribution to the Chapter for any material purchased from non-member suppliers.

**3. Assessable Work**

- Concrete pavement, shoulder, overlay; roller compacted concrete pavement/shoulder/base; precast concrete pavement. Only for concrete pavement projects: bridge approach slab and curb & gutter.
- Soil cement; econocrete; lean concrete base; cement treated permeable base; cementitious treated recycled base, cementitious stabilized base including full depth reclamation.
- Full/partial-depth patching; dowel/tie bar retrofit; diamond grooving/grinding; slab stabilization; joint assembly; expansion joint; joint/crack sawing, sealing, and resealing.

**4. Responsible Parties**

- Prime contractors are responsible for paying on assessable work that they do and on assessable work that is done by non-member subcontractors.
- Subcontractors are responsible for paying on all assessable work that they do, regardless of whether the prime contractor is a member or not.

**5. New Members**

- Assessments will not be owed on projects awarded/secured prior to joining ACPA/PA or ACPA/National. For companies rejoining ACPA/PA, active projects previously awarded/secured will be assessed on a prorated basis, using the notice to proceed, rejoining, and contract completion dates. Extraordinary assistance requested by the contractor for any non-assessed project will be at \$250/hour after the first eight hours, and at \$250/hour for ACPA/National members beginning with the first hour.
- Assessment rates for companies that have never previously belonged to ACPA/PA or ACPA/National are one-third the standard rate for the duration of any project awarded/secured during the first year of membership, and two-thirds for any project awarded/secured during the second year of membership.
- ACPA/National members joining ACPA/PA are not eligible for discounted assessment rates, but their first two years of annual dues will be reduced by one-half; companies are eligible once for this incentive.

**6. Effective Dates:**

- Approved November.4, 2019; revised June 11, 2020; revised August 26, 2022; annual dues are effective January 1, 2023. Assessment rates are effective with work awarded/secured after January 1, 2020; for work secured previously, the effective rates remain what they were at the time the work was secured. Fees reassessed annually.

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
